1. **Task Orders**

At the mandatory Pre-Proposal meeting the question was asked whether the second RFP (The Orange Team), for design, engineering, construction documents of the BRT program would be done on a task order basis or if one company would be performing all tasks involved up to bid packages.

The answer is “At this time it is RFTA’s intent to have one team (orange team) do all of the work up to the advertisement of bid packages but we are open to ideas each firm may present as part of their response to the Orange Team RFP.

2. **Sub-Contractors**

Question: The RFP clearly states that “Firms, including sub consultants, who are selected for the Program Support contract, are not eligible to compete for the Planning, Engineering, and Design services contract”. What does this mean and why is it included?

Answer: RFTA recognizes it is the ultimately the responsibility of each individual firm to conduct business in an ethical manner. An addendum to the RFP will be issued that removes the requirement for sub consultants on the Program Support Team to be ineligible for the BRT design contract. RFTA does caution proposers that if potential conflicts occur through review and oversight processes, certain items of work may be cancelled or firms supplanted to resolve such conflicts
