TRAVELING BY RFTA DURING THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

- **KEEP YOUR SPACE** – Please practice social distancing while at RFTA bus stops, stations and on buses. 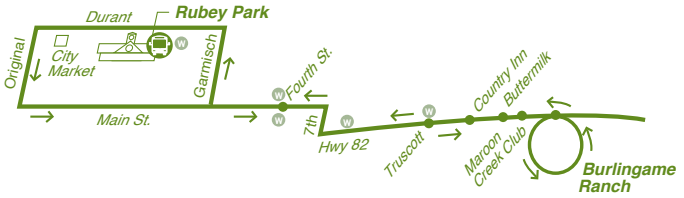
FREE Wireless Internet Connection Available at Rubey Park

Departs Rubey Park at :20 & :50 from 7:20 a.m. – 12:20 a.m.

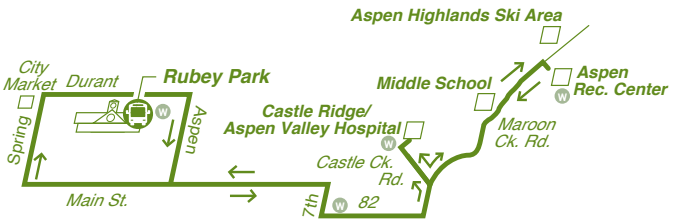
Route Note: This bus connects with down valley buses via the Buttermilk stop on Hwy 82.

Inbound: Departs Aspen Highlands at :00, :20 & :40 past each hour.

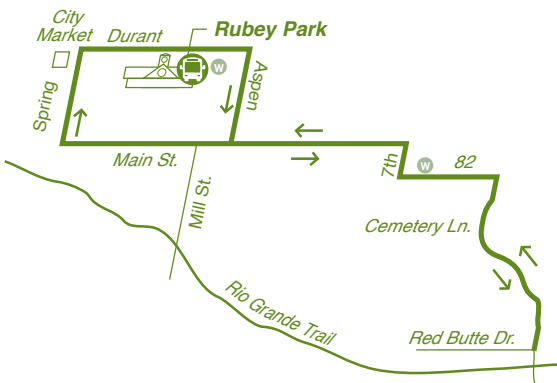
Departs Castle Ridge/Aspen Valley Hospital at :05, :25 & :45 past each hour.

Inbound: Departs Red Butte Drive at :12 & :42 past each hour.

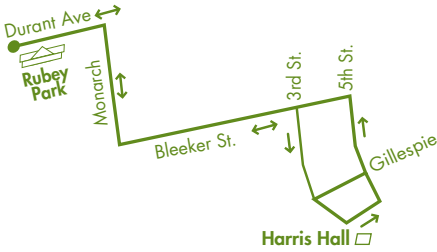
Cross Town Shuttle

Outbound: Departs Rubey Park Transit Center to Harris Hall at :06 & :36 past each hour.

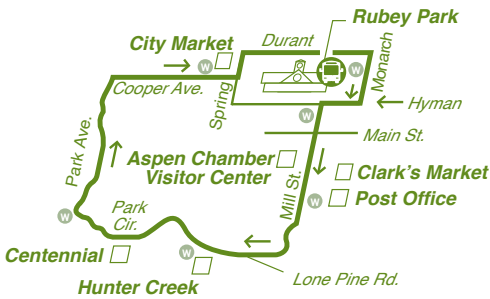
Inbound: Departs Harris Hall at :15 & :45 past each hour.

VISITING MAROON BELLS

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED:

- Before you arrive make a reservation at aspenchamber.org/maroon-bells.
- Tickets are \$15.95/person. Save your ticket to your phone or print it and bring it with you.
- Maroon Bells buses run from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

TO BOARD THE MAROON BELLS BUS AT ASPEN HIGHLANDS:

- **Park** at Aspen Highlands parking deck.
Parking costs are:
First 30 minutes Free
0.5 – 3 hrs \$10
3-8 hrs \$15
8+ hrs \$30
- OR **Take** the Free Castle/Maroon RFTA bus from Rubey Park Transit Center (located in downtown Aspen) to Aspen Highlands.
- **Masks** are required while riding RFTA buses.
