C7- Improvements to Mid Valley Highway 82 Bus Stations, \$

Project Description:

Five primary regional bus stops with the highest ridership along the highway 82 corridor have been identified as high priority bus stops in need of improvements. From experience is reasonable to assume that more comfortable and secure bus facilities will attract additional ridership and increase the boarding and alighting's at these bus stations. The six bus stations that have been prioritized for improvements are:

- Sage wood
- Lazy Glen
- Aspen Village
- Holland Hills
- Catherine Store

Improvements to these bus stops include the potential relocation and improvement of bus shelters, safety improvements to the highway 82 pedestrian crossings at each bus stop, improved lighting, improved bus bays, next bus signage and access to WIFI. Where appropriate, slip lanes, access for drop-offs, and TSP systems could be considered.

Project Cost Estimate:

\$1,603,172

Special Considerations:

These bus stops are within the CDOT highway 82 right of way and any improvements that requires construction outside of the CDOT ROW will require some land acquisitions. Coordination with CDOT and adherence to their access control plan and design guidelines will also be required.
