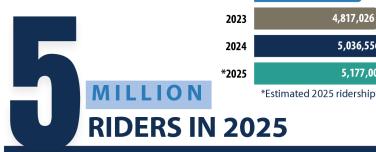

2026 BUDGETED REVENUES

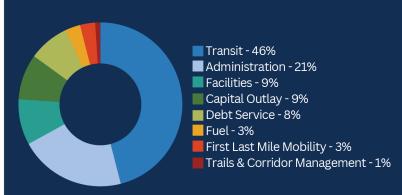
