TRAILS & PATHS

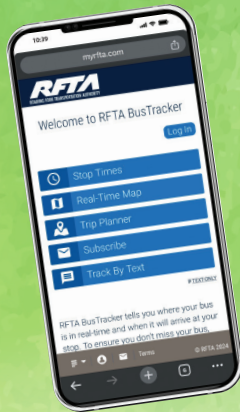

CATCHING A SHUTTLE

- When you see a bus approaching, look at its electronic sign to make sure it's serving your route.
- Signal the driver by waving or using the white reflective paddle located at most bus stops.

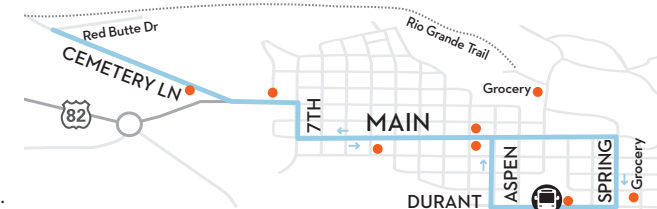


CL Cemetery Lane
